

## Directions to St. Swithun's Church

### From Motorway M3:

1. Leave the Motorway at Junction 4a. Follow the signs to Yateley.
2. You will pass *Minley Manor* on your left and *Gibraltar Barracks* on your right.
3. At the end of this road is a roundabout. Take the 2nd exit (right).
4. Go straight ahead at the next roundabout (2nd exit) across A30.
5. Take the 2nd turning left into Handford Lane (just after Telephone box and brown sign for *Casa De Cesarie*).
6. Follow this road – it becomes Hall Lane – to the Pelican crossing, where you turn left into Firgrove Road
7. The Church car park is immediately on your left.

### From A30 – Basingstoke direction:

1. Heading towards London, pass the *Blackbushe market* roundabout and *Blackbushe Airport* on your left.
2. At the roundabout after the airport, turn left – signed Yateley.
3. Follow instructions as from M3 at no 5 onwards above.

### From A30 – Camberley direction:

1. Heading out of Camberley on A30, pass through Blackwater.
2. Stay on A30 at the Hawley Lane/Reading Road roundabout (to avoid the centre of Yateley)
3. Pass the *Ely* restaurant and pub on your right and turn right at the roundabout shortly afterwards.
4. Follow instructions as from M3 at no 5 above.

### From Reading area

1. From A33 southbound towards Basingstoke, continue on this road until it becomes single carriageway. Turn left opposite the *Wellington statue* at Stratfield Saye
2. In about 300 yards go straight across at the next roundabout.
3. Follow signs to Yateley at left hand fork, passing Bramshill and *The Hatchgate* (on your right.)
4. At cross-roads, turn left and in about 100 yards, turn right at the roundabout, signed to Yateley, and follow this road through Eversley Cross until you come into Yateley.
5. You will pass a large playing field/green area on your right.
6. At the roundabout at the end of this green, turn right into Hall Lane.
7. Take the 2nd right into Firgrove Road.
8. The car park is immediately on your left.
